please click the START Button and choose "RUN...". Here you have to type "regedt32" for the registry editor.

Important: Call up "regedt32" and not "regedit".

Please note that you do the changes in the Registry on your own risk !

Go to HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\ENUM\PCI:



In the menu, select "Security" and then "Permissions..." A new window will apear:

Mark the entry "SYSTEM" and make sure that in the frame "Permissions" the options "Full Control" and "Read" are both marked with Allow. Now click on "Advanced..." to open the window Acces Control Settings for PCI.
